<u>Timothy McCabe-</u> 1 Clifford Street – Lot Line Adjustment – Mr. McCabe was before the board tonight to discuss an agreement for a land exchange between himself and his neighbor, Jeffrey Potter at 166 S. Main Street. At the present time Mr. McCabe in unable to perform—any maintenance on the <u>north</u> side of his <u>propertyhouse</u> due to the proximity of his neighbor's <u>boundaryproperty lines</u>. With this land exchange between the two neighbors, Mr. Potter's property will still be conforming to <u>Village codein area and bulk</u> and Mr. McCabe's property will have a decrease in his <u>existing</u> non-conforming lot.

Motion by Commissioner Zelnick, seconded by Commissioner Steinhoff to declare the Village of Ellenville Planning Board as lead agency on this project and as lead agency for an un-listed action according to SEQRA on said lot line adjustment issued a Negative Declaration determining the proposed action would not have a significant effect upon the environment.

Motion by Commissioner Steinhoff, seconded by Commissioner Nilo to approve the lot line adjustment in the amount of by adding 300 square feet 3 feet to for 1 Clifford Street, tax lot #91.86-3-2 and deducting the same from 166 S, Main Street.

<u>Excavation and Soil Mining</u> – Continued Discussion of revised local law – Dan Shuster told board members that on the latest <u>version_revision</u> of this law he has incorporated Paul Griegg's comments and sees no need for further changes. Board members thanked Mr. Shuster for all his work on this document and feel this should now be reviewed by the Village Board <u>for adoption</u>.

Motion by Trustee Maizer, seconded by Trustee Steinhoff that the Planning Board recommends the adoption of Article IV of the Village of Ellenville Zoning Law under Excavations and Soil Mining.

Other Discussion – Dan Shuster stated that the Planning Board should take pride and credit for their reviewing of the plans for the new RUPCO site on Broadhead Street along with the Ellenville Plaza on Route 209.
