MOTION AUTHORIZING TO APPLY FOR GRANT WASTEWATER ENGINEERING PLANT AGREEMENT #012714-12

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

Resolved that the Village Manager is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents and instruments necessary to bring about the Project and to fulfill the Village of Ellenville's obligation under the Engineering Planning Grant Agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER Resolved that the Village of Ellenville authorizes and appropriates a minimum of 20% local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program for the Village of Ellenville Wastewater Planning Engineering Study project. Under the Engineering Planning Grant Program, this local match must be at least 20% of the total project cost. The maximum local share appropriated subject to any changes agreed to by the Village Manager shall not exceed \$6,000.00, based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of \$30,000.00. The Village Manager may increase this local match through the use of in kind services with further approval from the Village of Ellenville. All in favor - Aye - motion carried
