

Minutes of the Joint Historic Preservation Commission

Village of Ellenville & Town of Wawarsing

Monday, April 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 P.M. by Chairman, Jeff Slade, with members Jeff Rubin, Bonnie Hull and Kay Hull present Paul Ross was absent..

The minutes of March 12th were approved as circulated.

Under "Old Business", Jeff Slade reported the new sign has been installed at the DeWitt-Benedict House and the next sign is expected to be placed on the site of the Hunt Building.

Regarding the Ellenville/Wawarsing Park, There was some discussion regarding a bond through Ulster County to be used specifically for Parks, Agriculture, Open Space and Recreational development. There is no further information regarding the fire station at this time.

Jeff Slade plans to follow up with Ms. Herscher regarding her request for a historic marker identifying the Old99er/Benny DePuy legend.

Jeff indicated he will contact Ms, Kortright to inform her that the farmhouse she owns in Kerhonkson is actually located in the Town of Rochester, not the Town of Wawarsing.

The Blueberry Festival will be held on Saturday, August 11, 2018.

Under "New Business", Mr. Slade stated revisions are being made to the Historic District brochure. He also spoke about Kate Cowing's interest in Yama Farms from the perspective of architectural preservation. He informed her that the site is a sad state of disrepair and will meet with her to discuss further,

There was no other "Commissioner Concerns" to discuss at this time.

The next meeting is scheduled for May 14, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. and today's meeting was adjourned at 4:40 p.m.
